IWA Holiday Centres

The Irish Wheelchair Association (IWA) provides accessible and supported holidays and breaks at our three holiday centres in Roscommon; Dublin; and Kilkenny. All share a person-centered ethos and offer:

- ▶ Personal assistance
- ▶ A standard range of aids and appliances, including high/low beds, hoists, showers and alarms
- ▶ Complete accessibility
- ▶ Organised outings and excursions
- ▶ Experienced and welcoming staff.

In addition, the Roscommon and Dublin centres can provide waking night duty and nursing care. All three centres are part-funded by the HSE.

Cuisle Holiday Centre, Roscommon

Our national holiday centre, Cuisle, in Donamon, Co Roscommon has 35 en suite bedrooms, with twin and double beds, and can accommodate 70 guests at a time. It is an integrated centre which caters for people with and without disabilities, giving families an opportunity to holiday together. All age groups are welcomed. Cuisle is open from February to December, including Christmas, Easter and bank holidays, and offers a range of special packages such as fishing, youth breaks, Halloween and Valentines.

Facilities include:

- ▶ Fishing from 31 accessible fishing bays on the River Suck, adjoining the centre, with fishing gear provided

- ▶ Nightly entertainment, including music, table quizzes, bingo and karaoke
- ▶ Church within complex facilitates guests who wish to attend daily mass or special ceremonies
- ▶ All bedrooms with TV
- ▶ Hairdressing salon, therapy room and hydrotherapy suite
- ▶ Day trips including shopping, bowling, sightseeing and visits to Knock
- ▶ Cinema room, sports, arts and crafts.

The Carmel Fallon Centre, Dublin

The Carmel Fallon Holiday Centre in Clontarf, Dublin, has six bedrooms and caters for people

with physical and sensory disabilities between 13 and 65 years of age. The centre hosts a range of themed breaks, including St Patrick's Weekend, Easter, Halloween, Christmas Shopping Week and a Hair and Make-up Artistry Week.

Claddagh Court Holiday Centre, Kilkenny

The Claddagh Court Holiday Centre in Kilkenny city has four bedrooms and provides holidays and breaks for children and adults under 65 years of age. The centre offers youth breaks, activity holidays and rest and relaxation breaks.
